Explanation




Statistics

I planned out my statistics for this process of social constructs like Religion, Age, Gender, Ethnicity, and Sexuality.




Religion


Age


Gender

predominant scale of insecurity was "3", and the predominant reason of insecurity was "Appearance."

In my studies I noticed that males are dominant within high self-esteem ranging from 1-3. Particularly males of christian religion, between the ages of 13-17, and heterosexual are the highest ranking of high self-esteem. Females show that their appearance is the one they feel the highest in self-esteem about.

Apparently, those that are at their lowest in self-esteem are high in feminine count. Actually, mostly everyone in the category are insecure about their appearance. Since females are dominant here my hypothesis proved well despite it being bitter in count. A good 75% of men were not insecure while the 25% were either moderate or low. There is also a good amount of women

Conclusion

Based on my studies of insecurities it is likely that women are prone to insecurities than men. But, based on outside statistics it also show that men are likely to express their feelings to the world through the means of hurting and or doing harm to others. Most homicidal and suicidal actions are predominantly men especially involving school and public place shootings. Ethnicity wise, it has been shown that people of Asian and White ethnicities tend to be more insecure about themselves than that of those from Black and Latino ethnicities. But this conflicts with my study because most of those who were black were more insecure than that of whites and any of the other ethnicities.

Homosexuals were not a big variable within my study because there was a mild amount of people who took the survey but I can say that homosexuals within society actually aren't very insecure and mildly insecure about themselves because sometimes they know whom they are. The only homosexual men that may be insecure is the ones that don't exactly want to be gay. On the other hand Heterosexuals are far more likely to be insecure about appearance and how they present themselves to the people in the society. They are afraid of judgement and do not like facing a crowd of onlookers that may actually judge them in a different light that has nothing to do with sexuality.

Religious insecurity seems to be a thing. Certain practices are very embarrassing to the person apart of the practices. Many religious backgrounds include women who are to shave their heads, in some religions men are to wear skirts instead of pants, in christianity men are in power and women are to be a product of the man not a significant other.
