



There have been numerous reports of children eating the chips off the walls causing lead poisoning.









For example, 10 to 11% of children below 7 in Overbrook have lead poisoning.

Il to 28% of these people are in poverty and 72 to 100% of these homes were built before the lead paint ban in 1980, giving Overbrook a lead risk score of 6 - 8 with 1 being unlikely and 10 being likely.
